EU PRESIDENCY WAS SYMBOLICALLY HANDED OVER FROM CZECH REPUBLIC TO SWEDEN ON 20/06/2009

On the occasion of one of the final cultural events of the Czech EU Presidency, the United Islands Festival, the Czech Republic was symbolically handing over the Presidency of the EU Council to Sweden by handing over a keg of beer from boat to boat on the Vltava river on 20 June 2009. Then, on 01 July 2009, Sweden will officially take over the Presidency of the Council of the European Union for six months.

Prime Minister Fredrik Reinfeldt presented on 23 June 2009 the work programme for Sweden's six months in the EU driving seat. It is firstly a question of leading the EU through the financial and economic crisis, dealing with unemployment in Europe and continuing the work to tackle climate change. The Informal Meeting of Directors General for Sport will be organised on 1st-2nd October 2009.

Spain will then take over the EU Presidency on 1st January 2010 and Belgium will follow from the 1st of July 2010.

During the last Informal meeting of the EU Sport Directors that was held in Prague, on 28-29 April 2009 during the Czech Presidency of the EU, the Sport Directors welcomed the initiative proposed by the European Commission (DGEAC) to set up an informal EU Working Group on Education and Training in Sport.

This informal EU Working Group established between interested Member States to exchange information and best practices will hold its first meeting on 1st July 2009. As first meeting, main objectives and detailed Terms of Reference will be discussed and finalised.

► **CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR PREPARATORY ACTION IN THE FIELD OF SPORT – EAC/21/2009**

The 2009 call for proposals serves to implement the 2009 Preparatory Action in the field of sport with the main objective to prepare future EU actions in this field, on the basis of priorities set in the White Paper on Sport. The call for proposals will support transnational projects to identify and test suitable networks and good practices in the field of sport, in the following areas:

- a) Promoting health-enhancing physical activity



- b) Promoting education and training in sport
- c) Promoting EU fundamental values by encouraging sport for persons with disabilities
- d) Promoting gender equality in sport

The following timetable will apply:

- ▶ 31/08/2009 - Deadline for submission of proposals
- ▶ Projects must start between 01/12/2009 and 31/03/2010

▶ CALL FOR PROPOSALS EACEA/06/09 - Grant for actions to develop/implement the European Qualifications Framework (EQF)

The objective of this call for proposals is to award grants to approximately 6-8 proposals, with participants from the maximum number of countries and sectors, to organise actions to facilitate consortia that will contribute to a successful and enduring implementation of the EQF, as an overarching framework to facilitate mobility and lifelong learning, through:

- support to the development, promotion and application of the learning outcomes approach for all qualifications at all levels,
- support to the development and implementation of overarching National Qualifications Frameworks (NQFs) based on learning outcomes at all levels,
- support the referencing of national qualifications levels to the EQF in a transparent and credible way supporting mutual trust between countries and sectors.

Deadline is 14 August 2009.

▶ CALL FOR PROPOSALS EACEA/07/09 - Support for European cooperation in Education and Training

The Call for proposals EACEA/07/09 was published under the European Commission's Lifelong Learning Programme in order to support European cooperation in education and training as the development and implementation of coherent and comprehensive national lifelong learning strategies is a crucial issue within the Education & Training Open Method of Coordination, which is the framework for European cooperation supporting national reforms in education and training.

This Call for proposals is divided in two distinct parts:

- **Part A** - Raising national awareness of lifelong learning strategies and of European cooperation in education and training
- **Part B** - Support for transnational cooperation in the development and implementation of national and regional lifelong learning strategies

Deadline for application is 14 August 2009.
