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# QUALITY ASSURANCE



- Ensures that agreed standards are met and maintained
- Stakeholders can trust in the quality of the product – an individual's knowledge, competence and skills
- Ensures parity and consistency across all provision and over time
- Unbiased with no conflict of interest

# Mapping Toolkit / Common Assessment Strategy



- **Employers/ Sector agree Functional Map & Competence Framework**
- **Training/education providers receive:**
  - **Mapping Toolkit**
    - Document for providers to show their qualification covers the European Standards
  - **Common Assessment Strategy**
    - Requirements for assessment
      - Facilities and Equipment
      - Support Systems
      - Occupational Competence of Tutors and Assessors
      - Occupational Competence of Quality Assurance Staff
      - Evidence Requirements
      - Practical Assessment

# Verification



- **Providers are verified against:**
  - **Competence Framework via the Mapping Toolkit**
  - **Common Assessment Strategy**
- **Providers who meet the criteria during the evaluation by the 3rd party are accredited at the European Level**
- **Employers and the public can have confidence that qualifications which have been accredited (and their graduates) have met the European standards**
